ROAD SAFETY OUTSIDE SCHOOL

We are writing to address a significant concern regarding the safety of our children and families during school drop-off and pick-up times.

We have received reports of unsafe driving practices and inconsiderate parking around the school premises, specifically:

Excessive speed when driving near the school.

Parking over driveways and in a manner that obstructs access or visibility.

Action Required:

We previously used safety cones and removed them hoping that responsible behaviour would continue.
