## HEALTH NOTICE

We have been notified of confirmed cases of **Scarlet Fever** within our setting.

**What to do:** If you have any concerns about your child's health or notice symptoms—such as a fever, sore throat, or a pink-red "sandpaper" rash—we advise you to **contact your GP or call 111**.

**Returning to school:** To prevent the spread of infection, children must remain at home until **at least 24 hours after starting their first dose of antibiotics**.

It has also been brought to our attention that there are a number of cases of **head lice**. Could I please ask that you check your children's hair and treat immediately if eggs or lice are visible. Could I also use this opportunity to remind all parents that children with long hair need to keep it tied up at all times in school. This is a health and safety measure but it does also lessen the chance of cross contamination.



## YEAR 6 ATHLETICS

A reminder that our Year 6 pupils will be visiting EPSV on **Wednesday 28th**. It's set to be an active day, so please ensure children arrive at school by **8:30 am** sharp for a prompt departure. 
