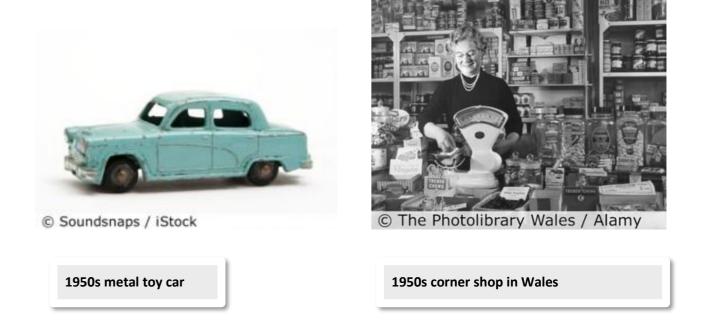


Important things to know

- 1. You can find out about the recent past by talking to your grandparents. We call this oral history.
- 2. You can find out what life was like in the recent past through looking at photographs or **objects**.
- 3. We describe time (chronology) using special words:
 - Decade is 10 years.
 - Century is one hundred years
 - A month has 4 weeks.
 - There are 12 months in a year.
- 4. Many toys today are **similar** to those played with by grandparents.
- 5. Toys today are usually made from **different** materials than in the past, for example plastic instead of wood or metal.
- 6. Some grandparents didn't have the electronic toys you have today.
- 7. Shops today are usually much bigger than when some grandparents were children. We call them supermarkets or hypermarkets.
- 8. Some grandparents mainly learned about the 3 'Rs' reading, writing and arithmetic. You learn about lots of different subjects.
