


(Y4U2) Roman Britain: What happened when the Roman people came to Britain?

1. Julius Caesar had two unsuccessful attempts to **invade** and **conquer** Britain in 54 and 55BC.
2. **Emperor** Claudius, the leader of the Roman **Empire**, planned a successful invasion in 43AD, he wanted resources from Britain.
3. Boudicca and her Celtic tribe fought back against the Romans but lost.
4. In many parts of Britain, there are Roman sites, including roads, villas and forts.
5. Hadrian's Wall is the most famous Roman site it separated Roman Britannia and unconquered Caledonia.
6. Roman towns were built very differently to Iron Age settlements.
7. Roman people brought many positive things to Britain. Such as; the calendar, roads, buildings, sewage system, baths and toilets. Their **impact** can still be seen today.

**invade:** to enter and take over a country through force
