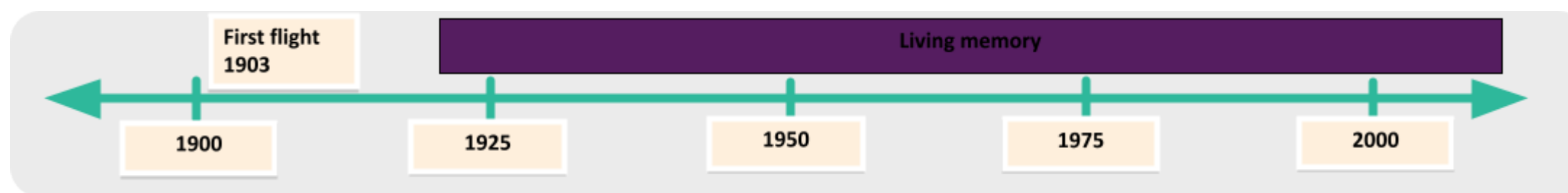
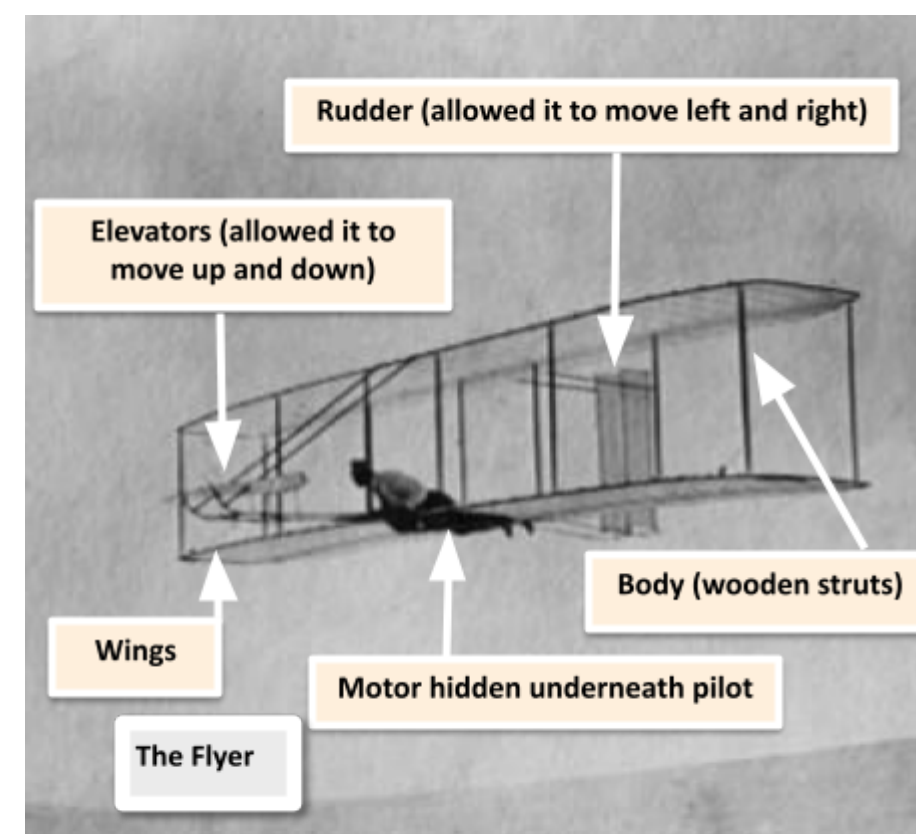


(Y2U3) Great inventions – transport: How did the first flight change the world?

The Wright brothers were **inventors** who invented the first successful powered aeroplane called The Flyer. The Flyer travelled only a very short distance and the flight took place in Kitty Hawk in North Carolina, USA. The Flyer was made from wood and fabric where today's planes are made from aluminium and plastic. Some features of planes are the same today as they were in 1903, for example the wings and rudder. Today, we use planes to travel for work or holidays, to **transport** food and other products. We know about the first flight by looking at **evidence** from objects, newspapers, photographs, films and 'eyewitness accounts'.
