

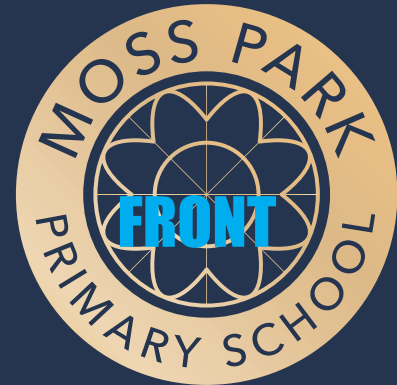

Our Pupil Passport effectively informs pupils and parents of the crucial end-of-year expectations, particularly highlighting areas where parental support can make a significant difference in their child's progress.

Buckle up, it's time to enjoy our journey together!

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- Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10 000 000.
- Round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy.
- Multiply multi-digit numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number.
- Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long division.
- Solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Use estimation to check answers to calculations.
- Solve problems involving the calculation of percentages.



- Explain their understanding through discussions, formal presentations and debates.
- Continue to read/discuss a wide range of challenging stories, poems, plays, non-fiction and reference books, myths, legends and fairy stories.
- Distinguish between fact and opinion.
- Infer characters' feelings, thoughts and motives and justify using evidence.
- Perform poems and playscripts for audience (using appropriate intonation, tone, volume to convey meaning).
- Discuss and explore meanings of words in context.



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- Use knowledge of morphology and etymology as a strategy for spelling.
- Use a thesaurus.
- Use hyphens to avoid ambiguity.
- Use colons to introduce a list and mark boundaries between clauses
- Integrate dialogue to advance action and convey character.
- Use wider range of cohesive devices (repetition of word/phrase, adverbials and ellipsis).
- Use further organisational and presentational devices to structure text.
