








- Children will all take part in a 30 minute reading lesson 4 times a week.







Spelling in Year 5:

- Each week we will learn and explore 2 spelling rules in 4 spelling lessons.
- This may be going over objectives from previous year groups or learning new ones.
- Each Friday, 10 spellings will be sent home for children to practise and these will be tested the following Friday.
- Please practise these in any way that you like, see the spelling menu on the website for ideas!

Maths in Year 5:

- Each maths lesson begins with a 15 minute Mastery in Number session and is followed by a 15 minute Arithmetic Lesson.
- Each objective in the Year 5 curriculum will be explored over 2 lessons. Lesson 1 involves all children focusing on fluency. In lesson 2, children who have mastered the fluency will move on to reasoning and problem solving questions. Children who struggled with the fluency will have a chance to revisit this before moving on.
- Please continue to encourage children to use times table rock stars as they will continue to use their times table and related division facts in their learning regularly throughout upper KS2.

Homework in Year 5:

 Maths, SPAG and Spelling homework will be set weekly on Friday and will be marked the following Friday.

• If there are any issues completing homework, please let us know before the Friday so that we can help to get this completed.

• Homework not completed on the Friday, without a reason why, will be completed in the children's lunchtime.

When you need support to make the right choice...

Sometimes we do not always make the right choices - our teachers and adults in school are always there to guide us to make the **right** ones!



What happens when we make the wrong choices?

Your teacher has a plan they will follow to help you make the **right choice**. This is the plan they will follow...

STAGE 1: Your teacher will give you a **reminder** to make the right choice.

STAGE 2: Your teacher will ask you to spend a few minutes away from the class and will have **a repair conversation** to give you strategies to make the right choice.

STAGE 3: Your teacher will ask you to fill out a **think sheet** and will discuss this with you at **break or lunchtime.**

STAGE 4: Your teacher will ask you to talk about your think sheet with Mrs Bolton or Miss Comish and will also discuss your think sheet with your parents.

Teachers will usually start on Stage 1, but they can choose to start at a later stage, if they need to.

Remember lunchtime staff and TASC staff will also expect you to make the right choices and will follow this plan.
