We are also delighted to be joined by Miss Foulkes for the Autumn and Summer terms as part of her teacher training.

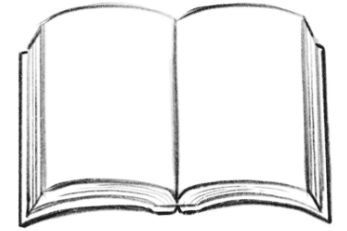

Reading



- Children need to read at home for about 20mins everyday.
- Please listen to your child read 4 times a week, chat and ask questions about their books.
- In school, we read in phonics and reading lessons. Reading skills will also be practised in group sessions, which are our Favourite Five books (comprehension with high quality questioning). Children also read their books with an adult through the week.
- Reading is key to all areas of the curriculum and needs practising regularly to keep skills sharp and developed.
- Books will be changed on a Friday.

Uniform



- As the children are representing the school it is important that the children are smart when coming to school.
- The children must be wearing school colours including socks.
- Encourage children with longer hair to tie their hair back.
- Please help us to keep our classroom clean by encouraging children to wipe their feet on the mat as they come in and use suitable footwear outside. You may still bring in wellies for your child to be left in school.
- Children must ensure that their shirts are tucked in.

P.E.
