

Along with over 500 other schools across the country, who were all online at the same time, the children got into the characters of aspiring space engineers and scientists. Via an online voting system, they decided the path of an Earth Observation mission, navigating orbiting satellites, whilst discovering a few surprises along the way. At the end, the children were involved in a live question and answer session, which they found fascinating.
