



Save the Pangolins...

Book your flight...

In early March, four astronauts will fly around the Moon and back on Artemis II, the first crewed flight under NASA's Artemis campaign. This is the first crewed NASA mission to fly around the Moon since 1972. NASA have said that this flight is another step toward crewed missions to the lunar surface and will help NASA prepare for future astronaut missions to Mars. We will be finding out more about the mission in assembly at school.

We have discovered that children (and adults) can 'send their name around the Moon' by registering on the site below. You only have to give your name and create a PIN number- you do not need to give any personal details or emails, unless you want to follow the mission. It will create special boarding pass for the mission for you. We thought some of our children (and parents) may like to have the chance to be a virtual part of this historic mission!

Submitted names will be included on an SD card that will fly inside Orion when the Artemis II mission launches in March.
