English

We will be studying Recounts and writing Journal articles this term, focusing on adverbs and prepositions in SPaG.

Class Read: 'The Fossil Girl' by Catherine Brighton and 'The Romans: Gods, Emperors and Dormice' by Marcia Williams

Science

Animals including Humans:
This term, we will continue with this topic, learning about diets, skeletons, muscles and how our body moves.

Maths

As well as lots of consolidation of our previous learning, we will be move on to:

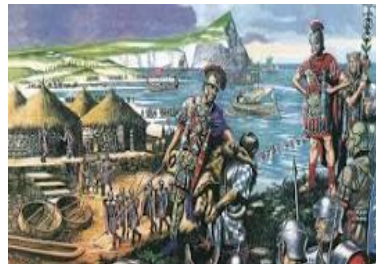
Multiplication and Division - using arrays, 2, 5 and 10 times tables revision, multiplying and dividing by 3, 4 and 8, making links between the times tables and division, written forms of multiplication and multiplying/dividing 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers.

Measurement (area) - counting squares, making shapes and comparing areas.

We use Times Tables Rock Stars to practise times tables. 5 minutes an evening is much more effective and helps the children with their retrieval skills so I have set this daily homework.

Tasks will also be set on Freckle for homework. I will send a SS message when this has been set and log in details are available on the class website.
