As you are aware, we rehearsed our lockdown procedure on Monday. I was so impressed with all the children, their behaviour and attitude was exemplary.

I have spoken to a couple of parents who asked if anything prompted us practicing it now, and the answer is no. We just felt, whilst we'd had the procedure in place for a long time, it was time to run through it with the children.

We explained to the children that we would use it if there was a danger outside, where it would be safer to be inside. Whereas an evacuation drill (fire) is where the danger is inside and it is safer to be outside.
