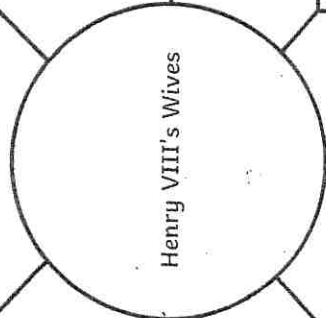

Catherine Parr



She is buried at Sudbury Castle, the only English castle to hold the tomb of a queen.

Catherine Howard



When they married on 28 July 1540, Henry was 49 and Catherine was about 17 or 19.

Jane Seymour



She was disturbingly related to both Anne Boleyn and Catherine Howard.

Anne Boleyn



She is iconic for her "B" initial necklace, which appears in many posthumous portraits.

Anne of Cleves



She is the only wife buried in Westminster Abbey.

Catherine of Aragon



She could speak Latin, French and Greek.
