Friday 30 October 10am – 4pm

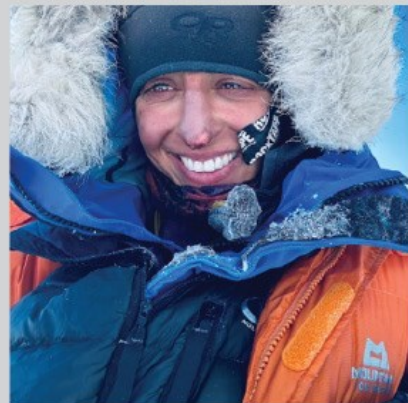
The Maison Dieu (Dover Town Hall)
