## Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Children will:

- Learn about friendship, kindness and sharing
- Talk about feelings and how to help others
- Take turns and work as part of a group



## Communication & Language

Children will:

- Build confidence speaking with adults and friends
- Learn new vocabulary through stories and rhymes
- Begin to retell events and stories in order



## Physical Development

**Gross motor:** running, jumping, climbing, balancing, bikes and ball skills

**Fine motor:** mark making, scissors, dough gym and dressing skills

Our learning experiences in Spring term A, will help us to explore the world around us; the season we are in and the different creatures that live in the local area and in other places around the world. We will also explore how to be healthy. Follow our learning river for information on what we will cover and ideas on how you can support this learning at home.



## Mathematics

Children will:

- Count and recognise numbers 3, 4 and 5
- Match numbers to quantities
- Explore how numbers are made up
- Identify simple shapes such as triangles and squares



## Literacy

Children will:

- Enjoy a wide range of stories and rhymes
- Recognise their own name
- Hear rhymes and initial sounds
- Draw shapes and begin writing their name



## Understanding the World

Children will:

- Explore winter, weather and seasonal change
- Learn about ice, freezing and melting
- Find out about animals that hibernate
- Begin learning about different jobs and countries



## Expressive Arts & Design

Children will:

- Explore materials, textures and colour mixing
- Draw and create with increasing detail
- Take part in pretend play and small world play
- Sing songs, play instruments and move to music





## Religious Education

Children will:

- Learn that Jesus was born for everyone
- Hear stories of Jesus welcoming children
- Learn the 'Glory Be' prayer
- Explore how we show love through kindness and care
