Autumn 2 – Diwali

The children enjoyed looking at their Chatterbox items: -

Diva lamps (Diwali), tea Lights, glow sticks, rangoli patterns



Children have learnt that Diwali is known as the 'festival of lights' houses, shops and public places are decorated with small oil lamps called diva lamps! The word Diwali means 'rows of lighted lamps'. The festival celebrates the victory of good over evil, light over darkness and knowledge over ignorance.
