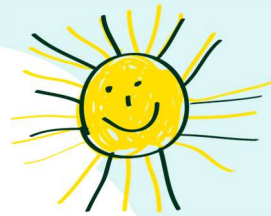


# St Andrew's C of E Infant School Newsletter

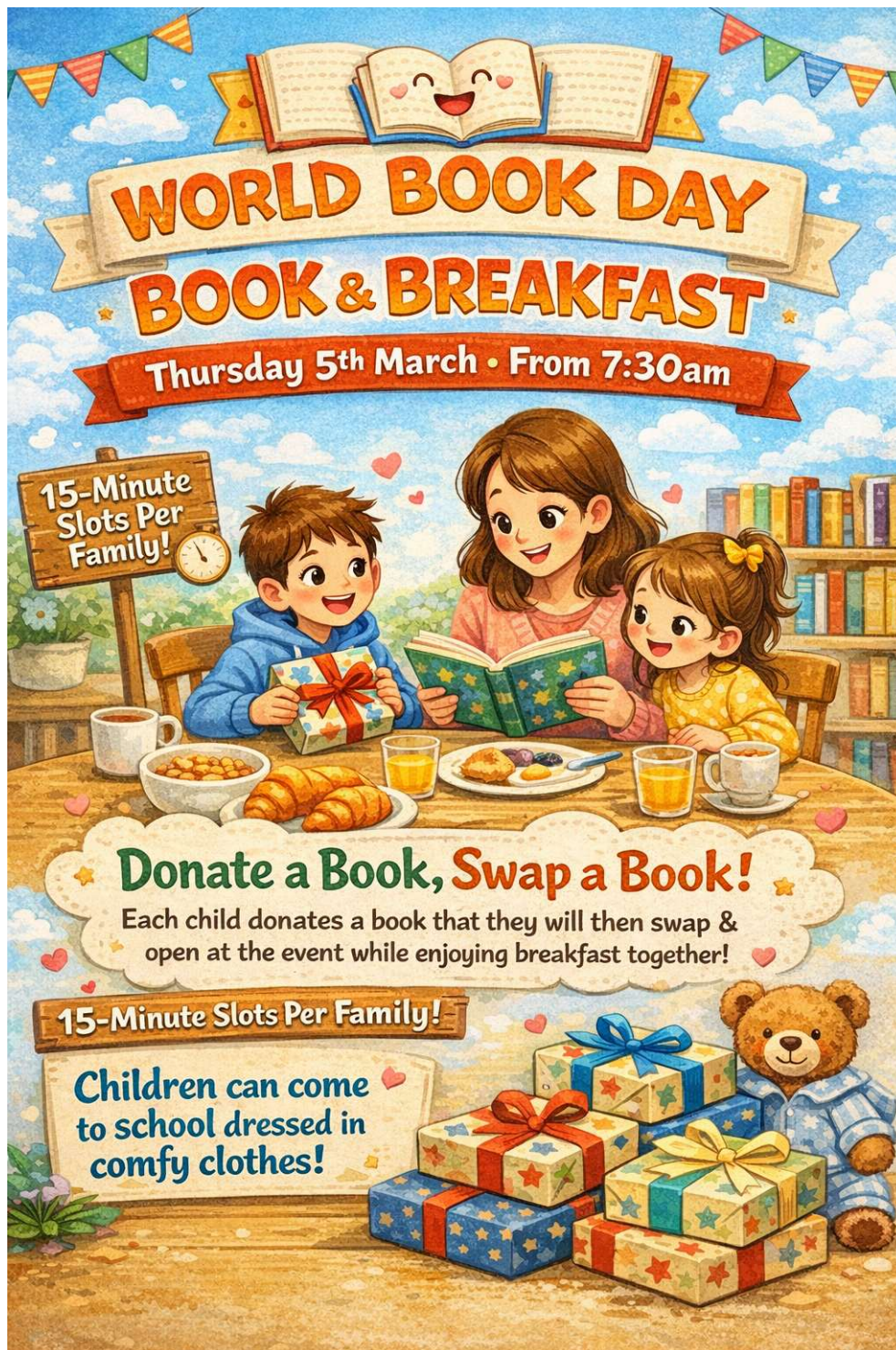
