This half term we have been learning all about the symbols of Easter and what they represent. We looked at the Paschal Candle, what it is used for and the meaning behind each symbol on it. We discussed the Eucharist and the reasons why Jesus shared bread and wine with his disciples. We tried hot cross buns, simnel cake and chocolate eggs whilst discussed why they are associated with Easter and which symbols truly represent the meaning of Easter. We also re-enacted the story of the last supper and discussed how those involved may have felt.

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## Easter around the world!

Tsougrisma is an egg tapping game played during Easter in Greece, symbolising strength and resilience. Egg tapping symbolizes the victory of life over death, strength over weakness, and perseverance in the face of challenges. It represents the triumph of Jesus Christ over sin and his resurrection, reinforcing the core message of Easter. The children decorated their own eggs and then played against each other.



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
