Harold the Giraffe visited Kingfishers to teach us all about how to look after our body and our feelings.

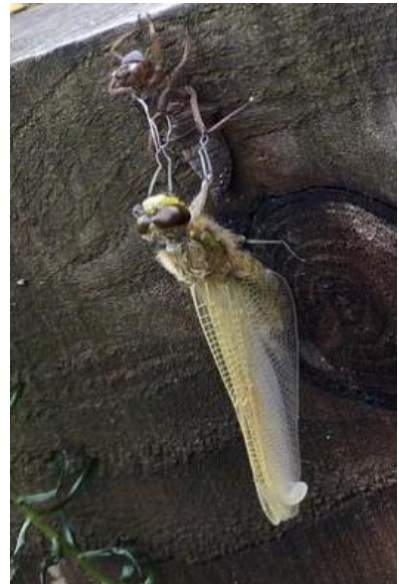


We had a visit from the fire station and learned all about how to stay safe at home.
