Here we are at the end of a happy and action-packed half-term!

We had a fantastic day celebrating **World Mental Health Day** on October 10th with a range of engaging and meaningful activities focused on well-being and connection.

The day was dedicated to opening up conversations about how to look after our mental health. All the classes watched this <u>short video</u> (kindly provided by one of our parents, Mrs Patel). Children participated in focused sessions to understand practical strategies for maintaining a healthy mind. A key activity was dedicated time for breathing exercises, teaching the children simple, powerful techniques to help them calm their bodies and minds when they feel worried or stressed.

We also spent time reflecting on what helps us feel secure, discussing the importance of our physical and emotional environments and considering what makes us feel safe.



The day culminated in our Key Stage 2 Oracy Assembly. The children demonstrated impressive speaking and listening skills and the assembly ended with a powerful, collective activity: we all wrote pledges to ensure that no one ever feels alone. These promises reinforced our school-wide commitment to kindness, inclusivity, and always reaching out to support one another.

Academisation update In July, we shared that the school leadership term and governing body have taken the exciting decision to join <u>Greater Manchester Education Trust</u>. This proposal is very much about building upon everything that is great about Queensgate and strengthening our school further. The official Listening period concluded in September and this showed that there were no concerns raised which would be problematic to the proposal moving forward. Therefore, Queensgate's formal application to join GMET has been submitted to the Department for Education and we expect to hear if the application has been successful in December. Health and Safety procedures Please be aware that we hold regular fire drill practices with the children in school (from Nursery upwards). They are all well trained and aware of the procedures to follow in the event of a real fire. Periodically, we also remind the children about what to do if we needed to enter the school quickly in case of an emergency. This is called a "lockdown" A lockdown occurs when circumstances dictate that the safety of pupils and staff is better ensured inside school buildings. We might use the word "lockdown" with some of our older pupils, but many children will be unaware of this terminology.

If there ever was to be an emergency in school, we would communicate any updates via email to our Queensgate families.

Author visit 17.10.25 What a treat Years 1, 2, and 3 had on Friday as we welcomed the fantastic author, Abie Longstaff, to our school! Abie shared insights into her book, *Little Bad Wolf - Before the Fairytale*, captivating the children with the story and explaining her creative process for writing it. Abie was equally impressed with our children commenting on their wonderful behaviour and the thoughtful questions they asked her about being an author.
