Make and explore white puffy paint with equal parts shaving foam and PVA glue.  For the majority of pupils, the focus will be on touching the puffy paint and exploring with our hands and taking a print.  Some pupils may spontaneously write and draw with their finger.  For other pupils' staff can model writing names and numbers in the puffy paint.  Sensory exploring ice cubes – both plain and flavoured.
