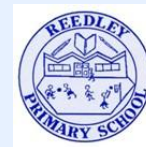

Phonics Screening Check

Miss Cowell will be holding a meeting for parents in Year 1 and selected parents in Year 2, to talk about the Phonics Screening Check that their children will carry out in June. If your child will be taking the test, you will receive an invite to the meeting via your phone. If you don't receive a message, your child will not be taking the test.

The meeting will be on Thursday 21st May from 2.30pm. Miss Cowell will explain the format of the test and there will be a chance for you to work with your child during the session.

Breakfast Club

Adults should not use the staff car park for dropping children off at breakfast club.
