Items not permitted in school

Smart Watches/Phones

Children are not allowed to wear smart watches for school. It is not part of the school uniform and could be a safeguarding risk if children have any devices with the facility to record other children or to send messages. Some functions could also give children an unfair advantage in their work. If children need a mobile phone for safety as they walk home alone, then phones must be switched off as they enter the school premises and left in the school office all day.

Football Cards

A number of children have been bringing football cards to school. This is not permitted. Cards should be left at home.

I have spoken to the children about this and they are aware that if further cards are brought into school, then they will remain in my office for a number of weeks.

The next session will be on Friday 13th February from 9am to 10am. There is no need to book, just turn up.



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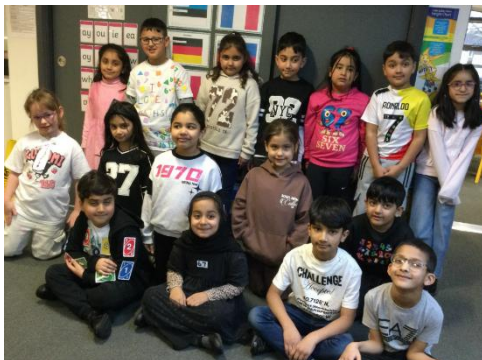

- 4) **Forty:** The only number with letters in alphabetical order.



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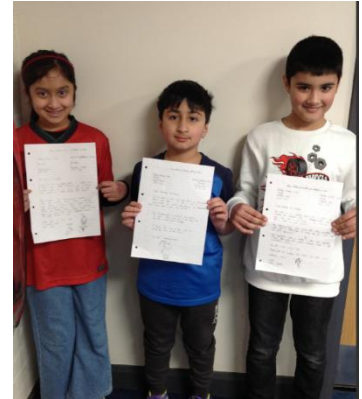
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Linking Schools

We recently made links with Northern Primary School in Bacup. We visited the school before Christmas to see their nativity show. This week we received letters from our friends at Northern School.

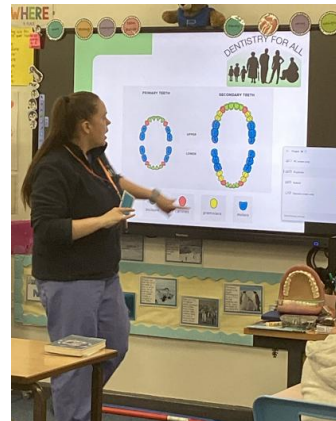
We are looking forward to when they come to visit us to watch our Eid assembly soon.

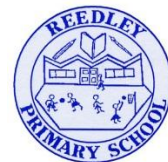
