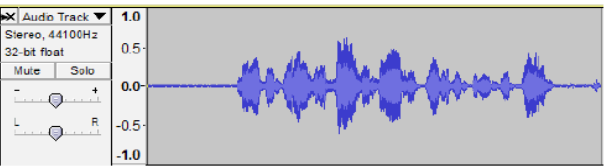
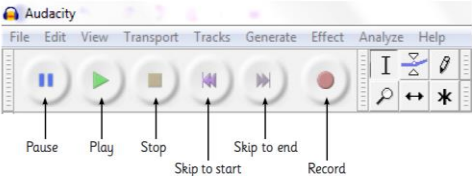
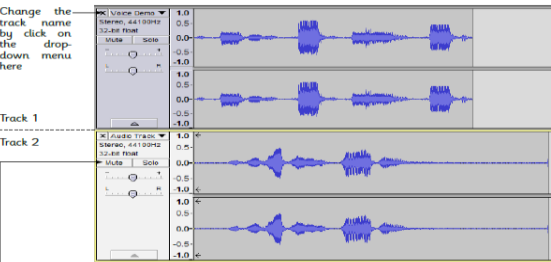

All sound recordings are displayed in a visual way known as a waveform. This shows the length and change in volume of the audio track.  To delete the entire audio track, click on the cross.			Clip A small sound file (noun) OR The same meaning as 'Trim' (verb)
Be safe online Don't click on strange links or pop-ups		Most buttons for audio devices or software follow a similar convention, so you should easily recognise what they are designed to do. The main toolbar buttons in Audacity have six basic functions: 		Computing Systems & Networks	Sound effect A sound other than speech or music made artificially for use in a play, film, or other broadcast production.
Check the first results carefully The top result isn't always the best or most correct – it might be AI or Wikipedia.		To highlight and select the entire track click anywhere in the grey box at the left hand-side. To highlight and select part of the track just click and drag over the required section of the waveform.  Change the track name by click on the drop-down menu here			Loop A repeating sound to allow continuous repetition.
Spot ads Sometimes the first links are ads . They might not have the answer you need.		Two (or more) tracks can be recorded and played at the same time. If you want to hear what one of them sounds like on its own, either click on Solo or Mute.		Impact of Technology	Mute To make something quiet or turn off the sound. For example, if you press the mute button on the TV or computer, you can't hear anything.
Double-check information Compare answers from more than one website. If they all agree, it's more likely true.					
Look for trusted sites Good sites often end with .org , .gov , .edu , or are well-known like BBC, National Geographic, or kids' learning sites.				Safety and Security	Unmute To turn the sound back on so you can hear again.
