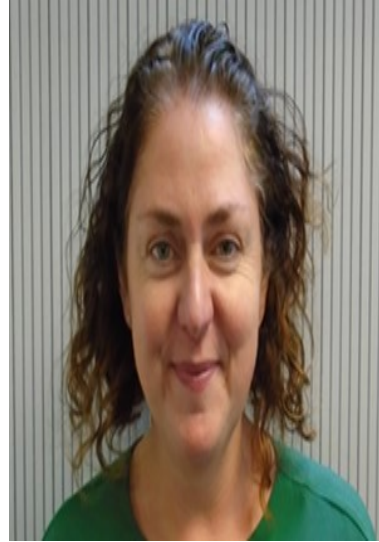

The Year 3 classrooms are in the main building.

In your classroom, you will have a space to keep your personal belongings. You are not allowed to bring any toys into school.

There will be space to hang up your bags and coats in your classroom and a space to keep your PE kit.

There are boy and girl toilets in the cloakrooms that are near your classroom.

School Day

When you arrive in the morning, your teacher will set a morning activity for you to complete whilst the register is taken.

8:45—You can enter your classroom and your teacher will be in there waiting to greet you

8:45—9:10 Register, ordering lunches and morning task

9:10 - 10:15 Lesson 1 (Maths or English)

10:15 - 10:40 Assembly

10:40 - 11:00 Playtime

11:00 -12:00 Lesson 2 (maths or English)

12:00 -1:10 Lunchtime

1:10 - 2:15 Whole class reading or Wider Curriculum

2:15 - 2:30—Class activity (this is usually outdoors)

2:30 - 3:30 Wider curriculum

In the afternoon, you will learn the wider curriculum subjects. These include Geography, History, Art, D.T, Science, R.E, P.E, computing, Personal Development, French and Music—there are so many exciting subjects to learn about! You will also practise your times tables, spellings and handwriting.

On Fridays, we stop learning at 3:15 for Tidy Friday, a chance to clean up all areas of the classroom and the school.

Equipment

In the Junior School, you will be provided with everything you need for your lessons. After Christmas, you are welcome to bring your own small pencil cases to school. Useful equipment would be:

- Several pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- Rubber
- Ruler (30 cm is best)
- Glue stick
- Coloured pencils
- A green biro
- A whiteboard pen

Pencil cases need to be small as larger pencil cases don't fit into our trays so you would be asked to take it home. You must remember to look after your equipment (and school's). It's a good idea to label all equipment from home and have some spares to keep in your tray in a clear plastic wallet.

You also need to bring a **water bottle** into school. This must have your name on and contain only water. There is drinking water in the school taps where you can refill your bottle.
