Pride of Yorkshire Lion Cub Fundraiser

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our school is raising money to support our Pride of Yorkshire lion cub. We are aiming to raise £950 and have put together a few events to do this. All money collected will go to the Children's Hospital.

We will be holding a 'Dress as a Lion day' on the 10th July. We ask that children donate £2 and they can come dressed as a lion. This could include wearing colours similar to that of a lion, wearing a full outfit of a lion, of having a few details in their outfit that are lion-esque. If they wish, the children could instead create a 'crazy mane' in which they style their hair in eccentric ways to create their own mane.

We will also be raising money through a sponsored obstacle course (please see sponsorship form attached). Each child will complete as many laps of the obstacle course as they can in 15 minutes. Please sponsor them for every lap completed or make a fixed donation. Our fundraising obstacle course will encourage children to use a range of physical, coordination, and perseverance skills as they complete as many laps as they can. Each lap will be around the school field, with four different obstacles for the children to tackle along the way.

Your child will receive a paper sponsorship form to complete at home. The children will then complete the obstacle course with their class before the 3rd of July. We ask that all sponsorship money is brought into school by the 3rd of July, in an envelope with the child's name on it.
