Maths

Over the next 6 weeks in maths, we will be focusing on:

Place Value (Within 20)

Addition and subtraction (within 20)

Music

In The Groove

Focusing on lots of different styles of music

ICT

Skills Showcase: Rocket to the moon!
This unit will be focusing on developing keyboard skills by designing rockets, creating digital materials lists, using drawing software and recording data.

Phonics

We will continue to streamline our phonics lessons with Saplings and Ash Class. Ensuring children are learning new sounds daily that match their phonic ability.

PE

This half term in PE we will be learning about Dance in the unit Fire, Fire!

DT

This half term the children will be learning about stitching and the children will be creating a puppet.

History

How have toys changed?

Sequencing toys on a time line, investigating artefacts from the past, identifying how teddy bears have changed and what toys may be like in the future.

English
