Maths

Over the next 5 weeks in maths, we will be learning:

Place Value (within 50)

Length and height

Mass and Volume

ICT

Programming 2: Codapillars.
Developing early programming skills.

RE

In RE we will be looking at the Easter Story. Celebrating new life and new beginnings.

PE

We are going to gymnastics developing our movement and co-ordination.

MUSIC

This half term we are going to be doing the unit Round and Round. Listening to Latin Bossa Nova, Film music, Big Band and Jazz, Mash-up, Latin Fusion.

Science

Animals: comparing animals.

This unit we will be learning about animals, comparing and grouping them by similarities and differences in characteristics, physical features and diets.

PSHE

Healthy lifestyles - In this unit we are going to be covering healthy living, keeping safe along with ourselves, growing and changing.

Art

Sculptures and 3D – Paper play.

This unit introduces children to paper-based 3D art forms, focusing on techniques like rolling paper tubes, shaping paper strips, and constructing imaginative sculptures. We will develop skills in creating 3D structures and applying painting skills in three-dimensional art, enhancing their understanding of form and construction.

Geography

What is the weather like in the UK?

In this unit we will be looking at the countries and cities that make up the UK, keeping a daily weather record and finding out more about hot and cold places in the UK.

Phonics

We will continue to develop our phonic knowledge using Fred talk to read words.
