RE

In RE, we will be learning about Creation, exploring the question: What are your favourite things in God's creation?

Art

In Art, we will explore sculpture by learning how to turn flat ideas into 3D creations using a range of materials, including clay. We will develop our skills in shape, form and texture while learning about the work of different artists, designers and craft makers.

PE

In PE, we will develop our underarm throwing skills and use simple tactics in team games, including attacking and defending.

Music

In Music, we will reflect, rewind and replay our learning through Western Classical music and revisit some of our favourite songs from Year 1.

Maths

Over the next 7 weeks in Maths, we will be learning about Place Value (within 100), Money and Time. We will build our confidence in counting, recognising value and telling the time.

Geography

In Geography, we will compare Blackpool and Accrington, exploring how the two places are similar and different. We will identify both human and physical features while developing our understanding of different areas within the UK.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be focusing on Happy Minds, families and positive relationships, shared responsibilities, communities, and ourselves as we grow and change, including transition.

English

In English, we will be exploring the story *No-Boy* by Sue Hendra. We will be looking at stories with fantasy settings, recounts and poems to learn by heart, alongside a range of creative learning opportunities and outcomes.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about plants and seasonal changes. We will identify and describe the basic parts of common flowering plants and trees and observe how plants change over time. We will also explore the four seasons, looking at changes in weather and daylight throughout the year.

ICT

In Computing, we will be creating programming animations by designing and programming characters to move on screen and tell stories.

Phonics

We will continue developing our phonics knowledge by using Fred Talk to help us blend sounds and read words with increasing confidence and accuracy.
