Uniform

Healthy Lifestyles

Cavendish Community Primary School is a healthy school and we promote healthy lifestyles. In KS1, your child will be provided with a fruit snack each day. **Your child must also have a drinking bottle in school each day and this must only be filled with water.**

Homework Expectations

We expect your child to read **every day** at home with an adult. Your child will be provided with a reading diary which should be used to add the date and a short note to say how they did. Each week, your child will receive spellings to learn and maths homework on Mymaths. Log in details and further information will be provided in September. Paper copies will be sent out to children who cannot access online resources. Time Table Rockstars is a brilliant resource which we also use to motivate children to practise their times tables. A separate log in will be given for that after Christmas as this links to their learning in class at that time. Homework will be given out on a Friday and will need to



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be completed by the following Wednesday. Your child needs to bring their book bag, reading book and reading diary in to school every day.

Learning Behaviour and Attitudes
