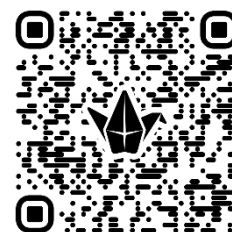
Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to the Stockport School Nursing Service. When your child starts school in September, we will take over their care from the Health Visiting Service. Our team includes Specialist Community Public Health Nurses, School Staff Nurses, Family Help School Nurse Assistants and School Nurse Assistants.

We can provide you with help, advice and support for any physical and emotional problems your child may encounter throughout their school life. We offer a wide range of support in line with the governments "Healthy Child Programme" such as the National Child Measurement Programme, supporting pupils with medical needs such as asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, anaphylaxis, advice around bedwetting and soiling and signposting and referring to other services such as the parenting team, GP, paediatrician and specialist continence services.
