Make sure you share it with your teachers and class mates.



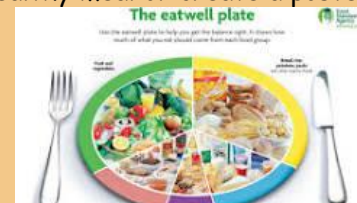
You could choose one activity per week from the grid below. Be as creative as you can and show off your uniqueness!
