Can they write the letters?

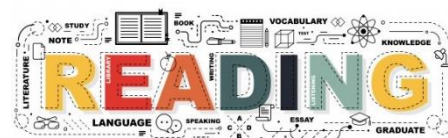
Can they spot the sound in the environment around them?

Choose one activity per week from the grid below. Be as creative as you can and show off your uniqueness!

<b>Birthdays</b> When is your birthday? Can you write down when your birthday is? Make a birthday card to celebrate a lovely birthday celebration. Share on Class Dojo.	<b>Welly Wander</b> We are starting our welly wander this half term. What is your welly size? Draw your wellies and write down your shoe size. Can you share your welly picture on Class Dojo?	<b>Harvest</b> We celebrate harvest this half term. Make a fruit and vegetable picture. Can you label the different fruit and vegetables?	<b>Where do you live?</b> Draw a picture of your home. If you can, write what number house you live at or write your house number and the street you live on. We look forward to you sharing your picture on Class Dojo.
<b>Welly Wander</b> Welly wander will take place in the school grounds. What do you see in the school playground? Draw a picture of the things you remember about your playground.	<b>Meal Time</b> When everyone in your house is sitting down to eat a meal, how many plates do you need? How many knives do you need? How many forks do you need? Can you work out how many things are on the table at a meal time?	<b>My Favourite Story</b> Share a favourite story book at home with your family and then draw a picture about it and post it on Class Dojo.
