#### THE POWER OF KINDNESS

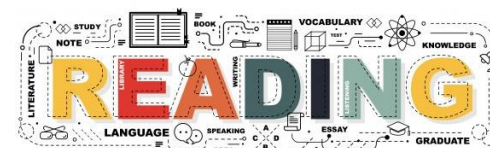
Sometimes things feel a little uncertain and even overwhelming, but one thing is for sure: small acts of kindness make a BIG difference.
