At St John's, we learn to read so that we can read to learn!

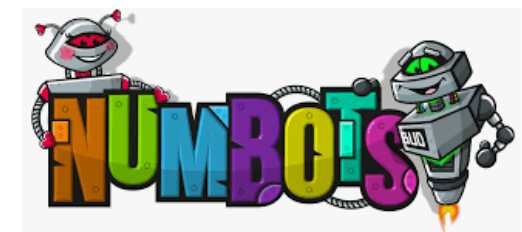
Spend 20 minutes reading each day and your mind will be forever thankful. This could be independently, with a family member or friend, or even reading to your pet at home! All reading is good reading.
