Read a range of texts including:

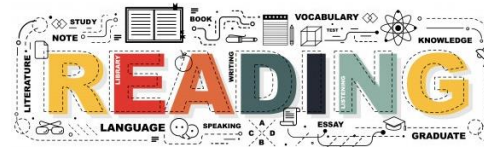
Menus
