### FREE CHOICE

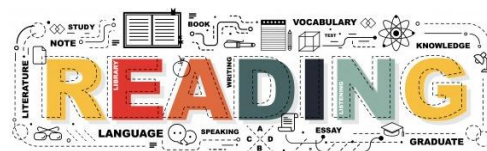
It's always important to have some freedom in what you do...
