Spend 20 minutes reading each day and your mind will be forever thankful. This could be independently, with a family member or friend, or even reading to your pet at home! All reading is good reading.

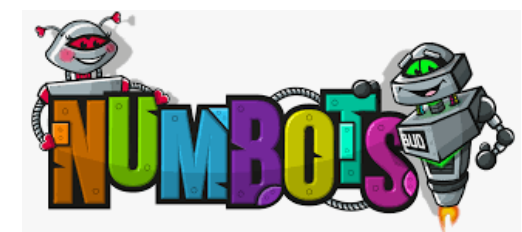
Find a calm and peaceful place, a book you love and transport yourself to another world.
