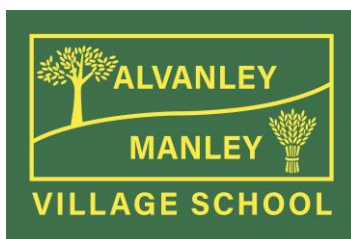

What we will be doing in the Autumn Term?

In Maths, we will be learning about Place Value and will be continuing to learn and practise times tables regularly. Our English unit is based on the book, 'Stone Age Boy'. Our history topic is the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. In Science we will be learning about animals including humans and learning about skeletons and nutrition. Later this term, we will also be going on a forest walk.

What will our classroom look like?
