



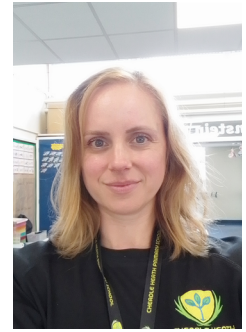

IMPORTANT INFO

- School start at 8:40am and ends at 3:15pm. Please be on time as we have a morning task which starts at 8.40am!
- Snack: fruit snack is provided for children in Early Years.
- School lunches: please remember to order your school meal from home so that we don't waste time in lessons. Reception age children are entitled to a free school meal.
- How to contact us: We can be contacted via class dojo or email. We will aim to reply within 48 hours unless it is an emergency.

HOW PARENTS / CARERS CAN HELP AT HOME

- Encourage independence by helping your child practise recognising their own name, getting dressed, using the toilet and tidying up.
- Talk, sing and play together everyday to develop communication skills, build language, imagination and confidence.
- Read together for 10 minutes every day.
- Support early Maths and Literacy through everyday activities such as counting, sorting, sharing stories and singing rhymes.
- Follow guidance and support for the delivery of our phonics programme
- Share any changes or information promptly so we can support your child.

We welcome all languages — tell us which languages you speak and we will help. We use lots of visuals, gestures and paired talk so everyone can join in straight away.
