## WHAT I EXPECT FROM YOU

## HOW I WILL HELP YOU

- I will support you settling into Nursery and building positive relationships with others.
- I will encourage your confidence, independence and a love of learning through play.
- I will care for you, listen to you and make our classroom a safe place to learn.
- I will help you try new things and celebrate your achievements and progress.

## IMPORTANT INFO

- Nursery starts at 8:45am and ends at 3pm.
- Snack: snack is provided but we ask that your child has a clearly labelled water bottle in school each day.
- If your child is having a school meal at lunchtime we ask that these are ordered from home.
- We ask that every child has their own pair of wellies and a spare set of clothes (including socks and underwear) and that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's full name.
- How to contact me: I can be contacted via class dojo or email. I'll aim to reply within 48 hours unless it is an emergency.

## HOW PARENTS / CARERS CAN HELP AT HOME

- Encourage independence by helping your child practise recognising their own name, getting dressed using the toilet and tidying up.
- Talk, read, sing and play together everyday to develop communication skills, build language, imagination and confidence.
- Support early Maths and Literacy through everyday activities such as counting, sorting, sharing stories and singing rhymes.
- Share any changes or information promptly so we can support your child.

### **If you are new to English or new to our school:**

We welcome all languages — tell us which languages you speak and we will help. We use lots of visuals, gestures and paired talk so everyone can join in straight away.
