- Make comparisons between the present day and moments in the past.

- Design a relief drawing depicting an event from the Ancient Olympics.
- Create a tile with the relief drawing as the design out of clay.

- Investigate the data collected by a Mars Rover and how it transmits it back to Earth.
- Read binary numbers and grasp the concept of binary addition.
- Relate binary signals (Boolean) to a simple character-based language

- Develop our skills as gymnasts.
- Develop our orienteering skills.
- Create and perform an industrial dance
- Develop our skills of sportsmanship.
