As scientists, we will...

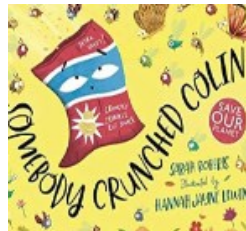
- * observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

- Continue to develop a range of reading skills such as running words, using picture cues, reading ahead to read accurately and fluently.
- Develop stamina in reading to read longer texts with confidence and understanding.
- Make links with the text that they are reading and other texts that they have read.
- Explain and discuss the meaning of what they have read.

- Use a range of adjectives to write expanded noun phrases to write a character description.
- Use imperative verbs, adverbs and adjectives to write instructions.
- Use conjunctions such as if, when, but, because to write detailed sentences in a letter.
- To consolidate knowledge of phase 5 sounds to make phonetically plausible attempts at writing words and sentences.

GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, we will

- we will revisit compass directions.
- Use a key to read and follow a map.
