As scientists, we will...

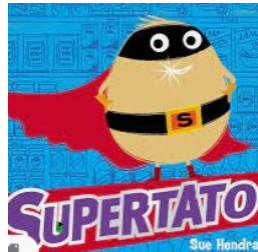
- Identify, name and draw different parts of the body.

As writers, we will...

- Use role play to act out key events and then generate our own sentences to retell the events of the story.
- Use knowledge of phase 3 and some 5 sounds and year 1 common exception words to write words, phrases and simple sentences.
- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

HISTORY

As historians we will

- Find out about significant historic events in our local community.
- Develop historical vocabulary.
- Sequence historic events in chronological order.
- Develop awareness of the changes in pupils' lives.

ART

As artists, we will...

- Explore colour mixing techniques.
- Use a range of lines and shapes to sketch.
- Explore shading.

COMPUTING

In computing, we will...

- Navigate around a range of APPS.
- Develop mouse skills and control a cursor.
- Develop early programming skills using a Bee-bot,

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

In P.E, we will...

- Develop our orienteering skills.
- Explore different ways to travel, showing awareness of space.
- Explore different ways to balance.

In P.S.H.E, we will...

- Understand the expectations of our class and school learning powers.
