
We will continue to practice our phase 2 and 3 sounds, and apply this knowledge to guided reading sessions.


PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will learn group games in the outdoor playground and we will spend time with the city coach learning object control and multi-skills.



MATHEMATICS

This half term we will continue to consolidate our understanding of cardinality, working with larger numbers within 10. We will explore the composition of number within 10 and compare numbers, reasoning which is more though our understanding of the number system. We will also explore capacity with a focus on weight.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

This half term we will learn all about the different animals that come from eggs and use scientific language including 'oviparous'. We will also learn about how people celebrate Easter around the world, and how it might be different from us.



EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN

We will be scientists and make observational drawings of animals that come from eggs! We will also take inspiration from some famous artists including Warhol, and Van Gogh to make our Spring time pictures.
