Unauthorised Leave of Absence

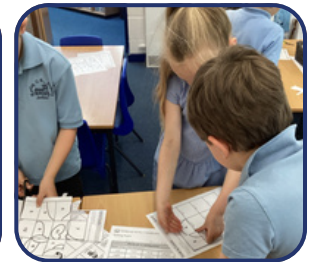
Children should attend school every day during term time. Holidays are not authorised and may lead to fines.
