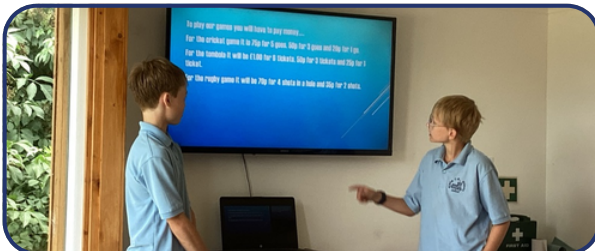
Staying Strong to the Final Bell! 📣
