## MUSICIAN OF THE MONTH - MARIA CAREY

Maria has won six Grammy Awards, nineteen World Music Awards, ten American Music Awards and fourteen Billboard Music Awards. She is also an inductee of the Songwriters Hall of Fame and was honoured with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame in 2015.
