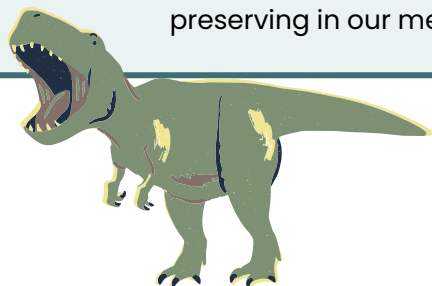
## WHERE IN THE WORLD?
