MUSICIAN OF THE MONTH

Ella got her first chance to sing when she was 17. It was on November 21, 1934, at the Harlem Opera House in New York when she entered a famous 'Amateur Night' contest. At first, she planned to dance, but felt nervous because of other dancers, so she decided to sing instead. She sang two songs by Connee Boswell, 'Judy' and 'The Object of My Affection'. Ella won first prize, which was \$25 (about \$650 today). This just shows how our nerves often help us to achieve more!
